SOHLNET AND STUDENTS FOR LIFE OF AMERICA TEAM UP TO MAKE A POWERFUL PROLIFE IMPACT ON CALIFORNIA COLLEGE CAMPUSES

This small ministry making a big impact in California

September 2009: Sohlnet brings Project Truth and the Genocide Awareness Project (GAP) to Sacramento City College at the invitation of the Student Government led by Steve Macias. Thousands of students see the truth of the abortion holocaust but faculty leadership demand that it be removed and then contribute to a trumped up and illegal recall effort on Macias. On Constitutional grounds Sohlnet and Macias stand and we complete two days of ministry on the campus. The Alliance Defense Fund (ADF) takes up the case for Macias, wins, and the incident get national coverage on Focus on the Family, national talk shows, internet blogs and Facebook. The media appearances disclose the character, persuasion and prolife knowledge of Macias, resulting in his securing a full time position as the West Coast Field Agent for Students for Life of America. In 2010 Macias teams up with Sohlnet and Project Truth, resulting in the establishment of multiple Students for Life Clubs on university and college campuses where we have taken our ministry. Little is BIG in the Kingdom of God. When John and Bud met with Steve in 2009 proposing to bring the GAP and our displays to the college, little did we know then how God would multiply our educational life saving capabilities.

September 2011: We may begin our Fall tour at U.C. Santa Cruz, probably the most radical and anti-God, anti-life campus in the U.C. system. We do expect serious and probably unlawful conduct against our members and our display. We will stand, speak and act on behalf of the innocents at the very gates of hell. Joy in Our Accomplishments: Beginning in 2008 we have taken our displays and ministry to 47 colleges and universities in California and Nevada. In each of the communities we visit we usually also visit the sidewalks of one or two local high schools where we hand out hundreds of prolife tracts. We have travelled thousands of miles, handed out tens of thousands of high quality prolife Christian magazines and tracts. Approximately 50 thousand students have seen our displays. Hundreds of students have acknowledged their transformation from pro-abortion to pro-life and many men and women have told us that a planned abortion would not happen because of the displays and our ministry on their campus. We have prayed with hundreds for healing of PAS as well as Christian commitments for salvation. Students for Life clubs have been established at many of the colleges as a result of our cooperation with Steve Macias who has travelled to campuses with us in 2010 and 2011. Members of Campus Christian clubs have thanked us for demonstrating our bold and graceful presentation of our Christian commitment to the sanctity of human life and our demeanor in the face of hateful opposition. Local proliferers in the communities we visit participate with us and are re-charged for prolife ministry.

Our Trials: We are constantly faced with hostile college administrators and campus police who either threaten us with removal, arrest, or relocation to some dark corner of the campus. We stand and prevail thanks to the work of our lawyers (Life Legal Defense Foundation). We sometimes get spit on and threats of violence toward us and our displays are common. Lastly, and too often, proliferers who have committed to join us at one or more of the colleges do not show up. (See back page for Our Needs)

Man to Man: Let's talk Abortion... by Steve Macias. A personal encounter at Sierra College during Project Truth Spring Tour 2011

Brothers, I would like to urge you to read this. So get a cup of your favorite beverage, put out the cat, turn off the TV and put your calls on hold.

This is a bit taboo but someone needs to address the apathy that men express concerning the health of their families and relationships.

I'd like to start with a conversation I had this week at Sierra College in Rocklin, CA . Where I met Aamir, a sophomore studying for a Communications degree while working to develop a meaningful relationship with his girlfriend Nahid. Aamir initially approached me upset, I was standing next to a graphic pro-life display that had offended him. "Dude, Why you gotta have these out here?" It's a common question and once I had explained that we were out trying to explain the reality of abortion, he began to open up. Aamir had been through a stressful last few months, he and Nahid found out they were pregnant. Aamir told me, "I wasn't ready. I still live with my parents, still in school and how am I going to have a kid? So we..." Aamir became choked up, "I don't know why I am telling you all this, I haven't told anyone and I don't even know you." I took Aamir aside and we talked out of everyone's earshot.

"We decided to have an abortion at the clinic in town (and) there were all kinds of people outside with signs. People offered to raise my kid for me, to help me out and everything. But we didn't listen and once I had got inside I threw away the stuff they gave me." I could see that Aamir was uncomfortable recalling it all, he clenched his hands together and took a deep breath. "I think about it all the time, we should've just gave it to that crazy lady" It's so hard to see people dealing with such pain and regret, but I knew it was good for him. He needs to confess and find forgiveness. I am glad he came to me so I could talk to him about finding healing. After a brief prayer he smiled, "Thanks for being out here man, keep up the good work."
